In continuation to this Council's Letter of Intent dated 15.06.2012 and with reference to your letter dated 18.06.2012, I am directed to convey the approval of the Board of Governors for establishment of a new medical college at Visakhapatnam, A.P. in the name and style of "NRI Institute of Medical Sciences, Sangivalasa, Visakhapatnam" by Anil Neerukonda Educational Society, Visakhapatnam with an annual intake of 150 (One Hundred Fifty) students with prospective effect i.e. from the academic year 2012-13 u/s 10 (A) of the IMC Act, 1956, as amended.

This permission of the Board of Governors, Medical Council of India for establishment of new medical college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievements of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per the norms of Medical Council of India.

In addition to above, this is further to inform you that while making admissions of your college to MBBS course it shall be ensured that:

- (i) No admission is permitted beyond the sanctioned intake capacity;
- (ii) Selection of Students to the Medical College is in accordance with the requirements laid down in the Graduate Medical Education Regulations, 1997;
- (iii) No admission is permitted beyond the cut-off date.

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admissions should be submitted within a fortnight of closure of admissions to the Council. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admissions in the College were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Council to proceed in accordance with law against the College.

I am further directed to inform that you and your institution are fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material, etc. throughout the academic year, as stipulated in Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permission of the Board of Governors and the said misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of MCI at any stage during the current academic year, your institution is not liable to be considered for renewal of permission for the next academic year and this letter of permission is also liable to be revoked for current academic year. Besides, MCI is entitled to take all

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The college shall not admit more than one batch of students against this letter of permission. The college shall also apply to Medical Council of India for renewal of permission well before the commencement of next academic session. While applying for such renewal, the achievements in terms of infrastructure, staff and equipments as spelt out in the time bound action plan and as per the norms by Medical Council of India, must be clearly indicated. The next batch of students shall not be admitted unless renewal of permission is granted by the Board of Governors, Medical Council of India/Central Government.

This permission is subject to the Bank Guarantee of Rs.9.50 crores (Rupees 2.00 crores towards medical college and 7.50 crores towards hospital facilities) furnished by Anil Neerukonda Educational Society, Visakhapatnam for the establishment of new medical college and hospital found to be adequate/genuine on all counts. The admission process for the academic year 2012-13 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997, as amended.

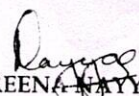

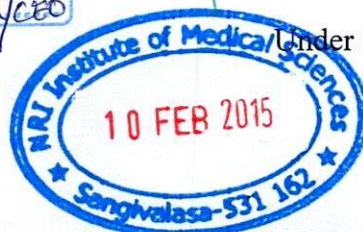

I am directed to inform you that an assessment of the physical and other teaching facilities available for renewal of permission for MBBS course of 4th batch (150 seats) of NRI Institute of Medical Sciences, Vishakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-2016 was carried out by the Council Assessors on 16th & 17th December 2014. The assessment report was considered by the Executive Committee of the Council at its meeting held on 13/01/2015 and it was decided as under:-

"The Executive Committee of the Council considered the Council Assessors report (16th & 17th December, 2014) and noted the following:-

- 1. Deficiency of faculty is 57 % as detailed in report.*
- 2. Shortage of Residents is 99 % as detailed in report.*
- 3. OPD attendance was only 210 on day of assessment.*
- 4. Bed occupancy was 10.36 % on day of assessment.*
- 5. There was NIL major operation and only 1 minor operation on day of assessment.*
- 6. ICUs: There was no patient in SICU & NICU/PICU and only 1 patient in ICCU on day of assessment.*
- 7. The following faculty have submitted fake telephone bills as proof of residence. After dialing the number mentioned in the bill, recorded message was heard saying "This is Anil Neelakonda Medical College. Please press the extension number."*

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8. No workshop on Medical Education Technology has been conducted by MEU during the year.
9. Pharmaco Vigilance Committee: No meetings have taken place during the year.
10. Lecture Theaters: Hospital lecture hall is not of gallery type.
11. Students' Hostels: There is no AC, Computer & Internet in the study room.
12. Residents' Hostels: Accommodation is available for 120 against requirement of 138. There is no AC, Computer & Internet in the study room.
13. Office of Dean and Medical Superintendent in the hospital are smaller in size than required as per Regulations.
14. Wards: Wards of Tb & Chest, Skin & VD and Psychiatry departments do not have Nursing station, Examination/Treatment room, Pantry, Duty room, Demonstration room. In other departments, demonstration room is common for 2 wards.
15. There was no Caesarean section on day of assessment.
16. Radiological and Laboratory investigation workload was grossly inadequate on day of assessment.
17. Histopathology & Cytopathology workload was NIL on day of assessment.
18. Separate casualty for Obstetrics is not available.
19. O.T.: Facilities in ENT O.T. are inadequate.
20. Anatomy department: Number of specimens are only 70.
21. RHTC: Cold chain equipment is not available.
22. UHC: Cold chain equipment is not available.
23. Other deficiencies as pointed out in the assessment report.

In view of the above, the Executive Committee of the Council decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to renew the permission for admission of 4th batch (150 seats) of NRI Institute of Medical Sciences, Vishakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh under Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, Andhra Pradesh u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2015-2016.

It was further decided to apply clause 8(3)(1)(b) & clause 8(3)(1)(d) of Establishment of Medical College Regulation (Amendment), 2010 (Part II), dated 16th April, 2010 which read as under:-

"8(3)(1).....

- (b) Colleges in the stage upto III renewal (i.e. Admission of fourth batch) till recognition of the institute for award of MBBS degree.

If it is observed during any regular inspection of the institute that the deficiency of teaching faculty and/or Residents is more than 20% and/or bed occupancy is <70%, such an institute will not be considered for renewal of permission in that Academic Year."

....

- (d) Colleges which are found to have employed teachers with faked/forged documents:

If it is observed during any institute is found to have employed a teacher with faked/forged documents and have submitted the declaration form of such a teacher, such an institute will not be considered for renewal of permission/recognition for

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award of MBBS degree/processing the applications for postgraduate courses for two academic years i.e. that academic year and the next academic year also.

In view of above, it was decided not to consider the institute for renewal of permission/recognition for award of MBBS degree/processing the applications for postgraduate courses for two academic years i.e. that academic year (i.e. 2015-16) and the next academic year (i.e. 2016-2017).

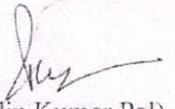

The Executive Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Sections 8)3)(2(, 8)3)(3 (& 8)3)(4 (of the Establishment of Medical Colleges Regulations)Amendment(, 2010)Part II (dated 16th April 2010 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under -:

8(3)...

- (2) *The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.*
- (3) *The procedure for 'Renewal 'of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.*

- (4) *Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause)a (supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute...."*

In view of above, you are, therefore, requested to issue necessary notification at the earliest recognizing of NRI Institute of Medical Sciences, Visakhapatnam for the award of MBBS degree when granted on or after Feb., 2017 by Dr .NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada.

S.O. In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of the section 11 of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956(102 of 1956), the Central Government, after consulting the Medical Council of India, hereby makes the following further amendments in the First Schedule to the said Act.

The same were communicated to the college authorities vide UGMEB's letter dated 24.05.2023 for compliance.

3. In response to the above, NRI Institute of Medical Sciences, Vijaywada has submitted their reply vide letter dated 03.06.2023 with regard to the deficiencies pointed out by UGMEB in its letter dated 24.05.2023. Subsequently, an opportunity of the personal hearing was also given to the college authorities on 17.06.2023.

4. After hearing the college authorities and careful consideration of the facts and compliance, it has been decided by the UGMEB that NRI Institute of Medical Sciences, Visakhapatnam is granted **one year** Continuation of Recognition of MBBS qualification. However, they shall apply afresh for Continuation of Recognition in 2024.

5. I am directed to convey that all medical colleges/Institutes having valid Letter of Permission (LoP) for MBBS admission are required to fill the details/data of respective Institutions on NMC portal for Annual Declaration as required in the NMC Act, 2019 and various regulations. Accordingly, through Public notices, all colleges/Institutions were directed to submit the details on the portal. Details submitted by your college have been assessed by the experts and accordingly your college was issued a show cause notice containing the details of deficiencies observed by the experts while evaluating the annual declaration form, video of examination, SAF-C provided by your college along with the AEBAS report.

2. Vide the above show cause notice issued to your college, it was directed to furnish the reply regarding each of the points raised in the show cause notice within three days (3 days) and give an explanation as to why the seats allocated to your institution for MBBS not be reduced in A-Y 2024-25, or should a monetary penalty as per the regulations not be imposed since your college has not fulfilled the provisions laid down under NMC Act 2019 and other various guidelines, regulation notified by NMC. Here, it is pertinent to reiterate that all the medical colleges were earlier continuously intimated in the form of circulars/public notices uploaded through NMC website and show cause notices stating to take necessary action to fulfill the provisions laid in various regulations and guidelines by NMC. Further, vide above show cause notice issued, your medical colleges were given an additional opportunity to submit the point-wise explanation on the observations, if any, through the virtual hearing before the Undergraduate Medical Education Board.

3. In the above virtual hearing, your college was represented by the Dean/Principal/Vice-Principal/HoD, who appeared before the Board on 30/04/2024. However, the clarifications furnished by your institution were not found convincing and satisfactory. The college also accepted the deficiencies and assured to fulfill the same within a very short span of time.

4. Since the portal for submission of Annual Declaration Form has been introduced first time, taking a lenient view the **Board decided to grant renewal of 150 seats for undergraduate (MBBS) for the year 2024-25 subject to deposit of a fine of Rs.6,00,000/- (Rupees Six lakhs only)** as a first measure; subsequently, after a gap of two months, the re-assessment of your college will be carried out. If deficiencies exist with your college, stringent action as mandated under MSMER-2023 Chapter-III clause-8 under the heading penalties shall be imposed.

5. As per, it is directed to remit the penalty amount

within seven days (7 days) into “**NMC Own Resources, Canara Bank Account No. 90682160000025, IFSC code CNRB0019109**” and forward confirmation of payment along with transaction details to ug.scn@nmc.org.in.

6. If you are not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the Board, you are free to prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within sixty days of the issue of this letter.

Sir/Madam,

I am directed to refer to the Public Notice issued by UGMEB vide dated 01.11.2024 uploaded on the NMC website on 06.11.2024, directing all medical colleges with valid Letters of Permission (LoP) to upload the details/data of their respective institutions on the NMC portal for the annual declaration, as required under the NMC Act, 2019 and various regulations issued by NMC from time to time, for the grant of renewal of MBBS seats for the academic year 2025-26.

2. Based on the details furnished by your college, the experts assessed the submissions, and accordingly, a Notice dated 11.05.2025 was issued highlighting the following deficiencies observed during the assessment:

- i. Fifteen (15) out of Nineteen (19) departments are deficient in faculty/Resident/ tutor as per AEBAS record data.
- ii. Deficiency of Bed occupancy (declared 78%).
- iii. Deficiency of Cadavers - Required 15, declared 10.
- iv. Data regarding Major & Minor OTs not provided.
- v. Birth/death data does not co-relate with clinical load details.
- vi. Lack of teaching experience in appointment of faculty as per TEQ for example - Dr. K. Lakshmi Narayana, AP, General Medicine.
- vii. Salary proof of faculty not attached in declaration forms.

3. Subsequently, the compliance report submitted by your Institution was also evaluated by the Assessors; however, amongst

other deficiencies, following key deficiencies were again highlighted w.r.t. your College/Institution:

- i. Fifteen (15) out of Nineteen (19) departments are still deficient in faculty/ Resident/ tutor as per AEBAS record data. However, your explanation has been accepted, therefore the college may adhere to the deficiencies found in the AEBAS.
- ii. Deficiency of Cadavers is still exists.

Further, it has been observed that during the renewal process for the previous year AY 2024-25, penalty was imposed and conditional renewal was granted in view of the substantive nature of deficiencies in your College.

4. The Competent Authority has reviewed the Annual Declaration Report (ADR) submitted by your college/institution and also the deficiencies pointed out by the experts. The compliance report submitted by the college has not been found to be convincing and satisfactory.

5. However, UGMEB has taken a lenient view and **decided to grant conditional renewal of 150 UG (MBBS) seats** for the academic year 2025-26, **subject to rectification of deficiencies with in four months from the issuance of this letter.**

6. A further review will be conducted after four months, and if the deficiencies are found to persist at that time, stringent action will be initiated as mandated under Chapter III, Clause 8 of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations (MSMER), 2023, and any other applicable rules or regulations.

7. If the College/Institution is not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the Board, you may prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within Sixty (60) days of the issue of this letter.
